## **Recommendations to authors**

The manuscripts should be sent to the Secretariat of the Académie on a CD, DVD or USB key or via e-mail sent to the following address: <a href="mailto:e-memoires@academie-chirurgie.fr">e-memoires@academie-chirurgie.fr</a>

- ◆ text: the documents should be in Microsoft Word for Windows (DOC or, if a DOC cannot be created, RTF) o "Times New Roman" is the only authorized font (but "Symbol" might be used if a text comprises Greek characters).
- o Use only boldface or italics (no underlining).
- o The article should feature clear headings, at least "Introduction" and "Conclusion."
- o Use the plan / style sheet functions in Word as much as possible, applying exclusively the "Normal" style for the text and the "Title1" to "Title4" styles for the titles.
- ♦ tables and charts must be generated using the "Table" function in Word, not using tabulations (as a rule, tabulations should not be used).
- ♦ graphs must be generated using the "Graph" function in MS Office (Word/Excel), not the drawing function in Word. Drawings and diagrams in Word or WordArt will not be processed.
- ♦ figures have to be on separate pages from the text document, numbered Figure 1 to Figure 99 99 (JPEG format 1024x768 pixels, 0% compression for photographs, GIF format for diagrams and drawings), and at least 600 pixels wide. Their reference in the text has to be clear, their place specified, and their caption integrated with the text. Power Point documents will not processed.
- ◆ Video documents will preferably be provided in wmv (Windows Media Video) format, versions 8 or 9, rate between 300 and 400 Kbits/s, or, if a wmv cannot be created, in a format we can easily transcode, such as uncompressed AVI (transfer from a DV camcorder). DIVX, RA/RAM (Real Media) or MOV (Quicktime) formats will not processed.
- ◆ references: the references (no more than 30 if possible) should be numbered in the order they appear in the text. They should be placed at the end of the text under the heading "References" (standard presentation norms), numbered 1 to N, and the references in the text should appear as (1) (2) or [1] [2]. No footnotes or endnotes!
- ♦ abstracts: the texts will be written in French, preceded with abstracts in both French and English, 250 word-long maximum (using the Objective/Patients and

Method/Results/Discussion/Conclusion norms). The abstracts should include **keywords** in French and in English.

- ♦ the title in English is to appear before the abstract in English.
- ◆ mention of the author: name, first name, affiliation, fax number, postal and electronic adresses for correspondance.
- ♦ When illustrations are reproductions, the name of their author should be mentioned
